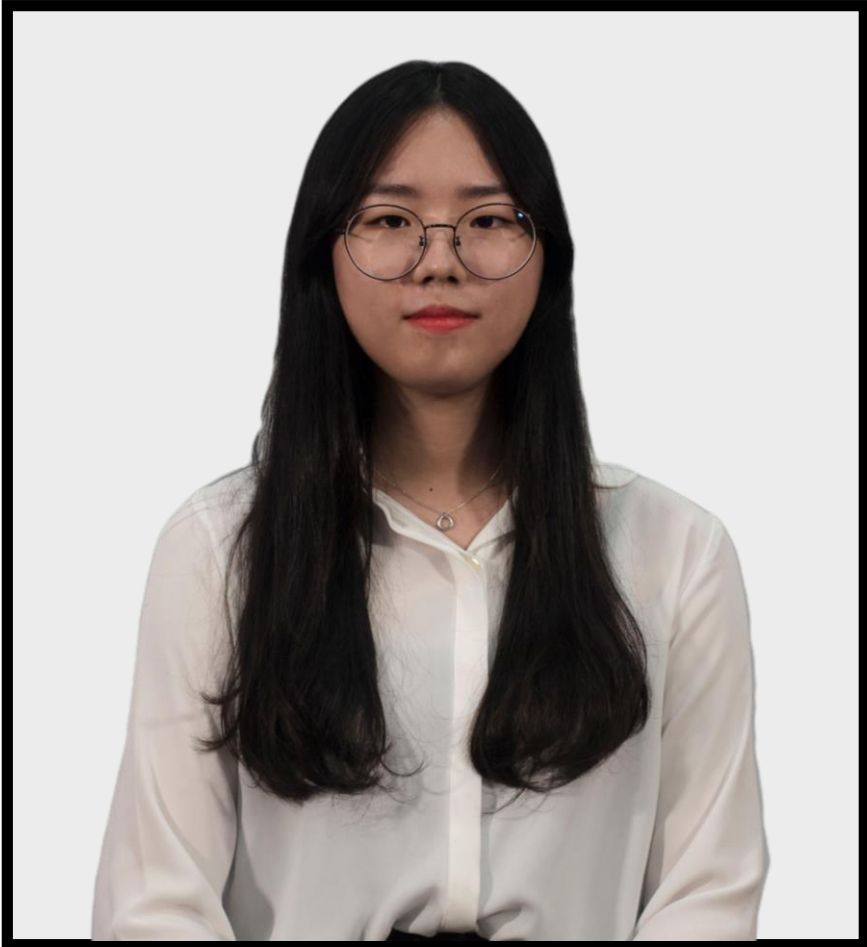

COMMITTEE: General Assembly 4

QUESTION OF: Territorial dispute between nations

MAIN-SUBMITTER: Republic of Korea

CO-SUBMITTER: United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Russian Federation, Republic of Poland, Japan, People's Republic of China, The State of Israel, People's Republic of Bangladesh

→ Both Main-Submitter and Co-Submitters' country names should be written in the official form

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY 4,

Emphasizing the significance of artificial island built by China which exacerbates the situation of territorial dispute, while the authority is downplaying the significance in order to obtain an advantage,

Reaffirming the conflict between Israel and Palestine which causes tremendous physical casualties and refugees, and further draws attention to the two-state solution which is believed by major nationals to be the most peaceful solution,

→ All of the Preambulatory clauses should include a **STARTER PHRASE** at the beginning

→ Each resolution should have at least 5 preambulatory clauses to pass

1. Strongly encourages countries to reach an agreement over the disputed area to allow its denizens to choose their desired place of residence;

→ When an operative clause doesn't have any sub-clauses, it should end with a semicolon (;)



RESOLUTION FORMAT

2. Calls upon the member states to widely share and publish historical information to the public in relation to the existing territorial dispute in such ways but not limited to: → When sub-clauses are followed after an operative clause, the transition mark should be a colon (:)

a. opening information and data with free access to the public, → Moving from one sub-clause to another, a comma should be used (,)

b. investigating historical artifacts in both fair and righteous perspective through making recruitments via initiating certificate examinations,

c. publicly exhibiting histories and past records relating to territories in context and issue; → All of the operative clauses should end with a semicolon (;)

3. Requests suitable and appropriate NGOs to aid buffer zones with monthly assistance of citizens in forms such as but not limited to:

a. giving monetary aid,

b. supplying medical assistance such as: → When sub-sub-clauses are followed by a sub-clause, the transition mark should be a colon (:)

i. equipment for treatment, → Moving from one sub-sub-clause to another, a comma should be used (,)

ii. medically trained volunteers,

iii. medicine; → Operative clause that ends with a sub-sub-clause should also end with a semicolon (;)

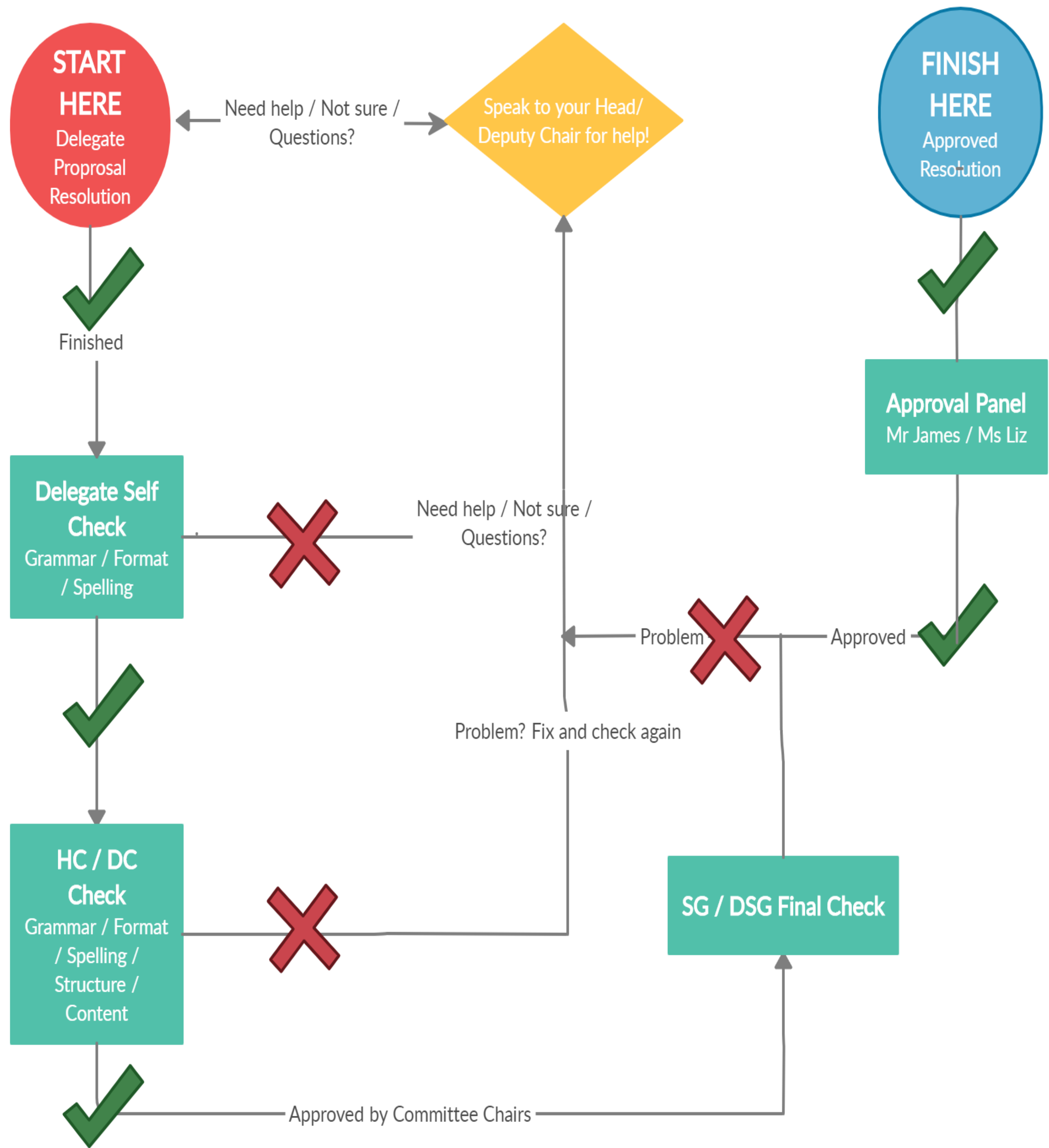
→ The beginning of the operative clause should include a number, starter phrase, and should be underlined

→ Each resolution should have at least 7 operative clauses to pass

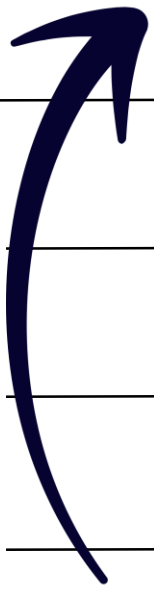
